# Donate to an Impact Fund



Type of Fund	Focus
<i>Lillian Fund</i>	Join a giving circle that helps women and children in need. With a gift of \$100 or more, you or the woman you honor may vote on the project that receives funding.
<i>PJ Library Fund</i>	Reach out to Jewish families with young children to foster curiosity about their Jewish heritage. Children ages six months to five years receive a monthly gift of a book or piece of music touching on a variety of Jewish themes related to Jewish holidays, folk tales and family life.
<i>Fund for Special Needs</i>	Enable people with disabilities to lead full and independent lives and be part of our community. The Fund for Special Needs awards grants to Jewish Family Services, the Jewish Association for Community Living and other programs serving challenged populations.
<i>Fund for the Elderly</i>	Support projects and programs that allow seniors to age with dignity, with opportunities to remain active, both mentally and physically. Grants are awarded to local agencies serving the elderly help meet basic needs of seniors.
<i>Children's Fund</i>	Support programs that benefit children, including Hartford Jewish Coalition for Literacy, which provides volunteers who tutor at-risk students in kindergarten through the 3rd grade throughout the school year to help ensure that they will read independently by 4th grade.

Type of Fund	Focus
<i>The Foundation Fund</i>	Help the Foundation take care of our Jewish community: provide support for charitable programs and institutions; encourage family philanthropy; and promote high impact grantmaking.
<i>The Israel Fund</i>	Join a collective giving circle of people who care about Israel. Experience philanthropy first-hand through the support and selection of projects in Israel that benefit disadvantaged populations.
<i>Fund for Social Justice</i>	Fund projects that enhance the prophetic value of “ <i>tikkum olam</i> ” the rabbinic injunction that we ever seek to “repair” our imperfect world. These projects will be carried out under the auspices of the Jewish Community Relations Council.
<i>The Helping Fund</i>	Assist unemployed families who are having trouble making ends meet. The Helping Fund provides needed dollars to Jewish Family Services so it can respond to the increased demand for financial assistance, food, shelter and other forms of emergency aid.
<i>Jonathan’s Dream Playground Fund</i>	Preserve this community based handicapped accessible playground at the Mandell Jewish Community Center. This fund provides for maintenance of Jonathan’s Dream Playground and allows future generations of children in the Greater Hartford area to experience this extraordinary place.
